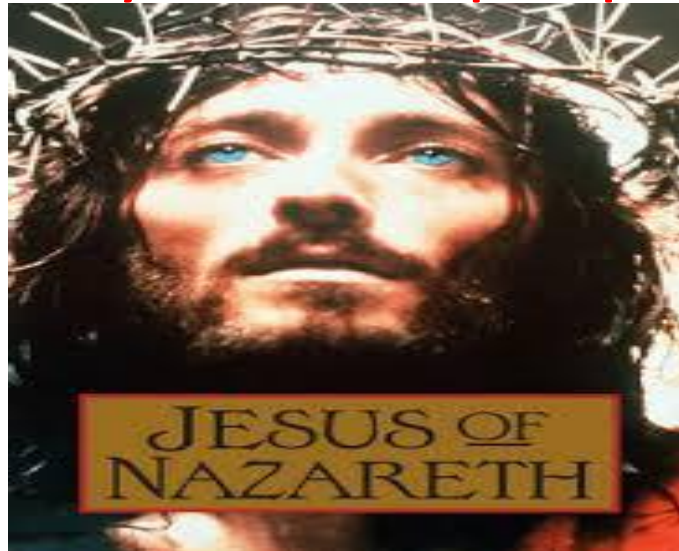
Jesus, Messiah of Israel

He is the lamb, of God



He fulfilled many prophecies

- Was born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2)
- Was born to a virgin (Gen 3:15)
- Called out of Egypt (Hosea 11:1)
- Was rejected by His own people (Isaiah 63;3)



Prophecies about Him, beforehand

- Is the stone the builders rejected, which then became the cornerstone (Psalm 118:22)
- Is the gentle king who entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey (Zech 9:9)



Was betrayed

- Was betrayed by a friend (Psalm 41:9)
- Was betrayed for 30 pieces of silver (Zech 11:12)
- Was accused by false witnesses (Psalm 35:11)



He healed those in need

- Healed the blind, deaf, lame and dumb (Is 35:5)
- Bore our sicknesses (Is 53:4)



Mistreated by His own people

- Was spat upon,..and whipped(Is 50:6)
- Was hated without a cause (Psalm 35:19)
- Was pierced for our transgressions (Is 53)
- Was crushed for our iniquities (Zech 12:10)
- Suffered for the sins of many (Is 53:10)



Died without natural cause, a very cruel death

- Died among criminals (Is 53:12)
- Was put to death, but not because of His own transgressions (Is 53:5; Dan 9:26)



Suffered,died and was buried

- Died before the destruction of the 2nd temple (Dan 9:24)
- Had His garments divided amongst those who “tossed” for them (Ps 22:18)
- Was buried with the rich (IS 53:9)

Rose from the dead ... empty tomb

- Was resurrected from the dead (Ps 16:10; 49:15)



Isaiah 11:4-9 ..what's to come

- ⁴ But ^ewith righteousness He shall judge the poor,
- And decide with equity for the meek of the earth;
- He shall ^fstrike the earth with the rod of His mouth,
- And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.
- ⁵ Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins,
- And faithfulness the belt of His waist.
- ⁶ “The ^gwolf also shall dwell with the lamb,
- The leopard shall lie down with the young goat,
- The calf and the young lion and the fatling together;
- And a little child shall lead them.
- ⁷ The cow and the bear shall graze;
- Their young ones shall lie down together;
- And the lion shall eat straw like the ox.
- ⁸ The nursing child shall play by the cobra’s hole,
- And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper’s den.
- ⁹ ^hThey shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain,
- For ⁱthe earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD
- As the waters cover the sea.

Micah 4:2-3 .. What we can expect

- 2 Many nations shall come and say,
- “Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord,
- To the house of the God of Jacob;
- He will teach us His ways,
- And we shall walk in His paths.”
- For out of Zion the law shall go forth,
- And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem
- 3 He shall judge between many peoples,
- And rebuke strong nations afar off;
- They shall beat their swords into plowshares
- And their spears into pruning hooks;
- Nation shall not lift up sword against nation,
- Neither shall they learn war anymore.

- **11** Then I saw iheaven opened, and behold, ka white horse! The one sitting on it is called !Faithful and True, and min righteousness he judges and makes war.
- **12** nHis eyes are like a flame of fire, and on his head are omany diadems, and he has pa name written that no one knows but himself.
- **13** He is clothed in qa robe dipped in 4 blood, and the name by which he is called is !The Word of God.
- **14** And the armies of heaven, sarrayed in fine linen, white and pure, twere following him on white horses.

Rules in Justice:...Are you ready??

- ¹⁵ uFrom his mouth comes a sharp sword vwith which to strike down the nations, and whe will rule³ them with a rod of iron. xHe will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.



His suffering and crucifixion

- [John 19:28-37](#)

After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!" Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put *it* on hyssop, and put *it* to His mouth. So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, 'It is finished!' And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit. Therefore, because it was the Preparation *Day*, that the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away. Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was crucified with Him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs. But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. And he who has seen has testified, and his testimony is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you may believe. For these things were done that the Scripture should be fulfilled, "*Not one of His bones shall be broken.*" And again another Scripture says, "*They shall look on Him whom they pierced.*"
